West Windsor Recreation Policies

REGISTRATION

All Division of Recreation and Parks programs are open to everyone, unless otherwise noted. Register early, as all programs are on a first-come, first-served basis. Please note that some programs have special age requirements. **ONLINE REGISTRATION AND CREDIT CARDS ACCEPTED** (for most programs). Visa and MasterCard will be accepted online and in person (minimum charge of \$25 required). Mail-in or walk-in registration will also be accepted for all programs. Certain programs require specific registration forms. Check program information for which programs require separate registration forms. For further information, contact the Recreation Office at 799-6141.

REGISTRATION DATES

Registration begins March 4 for most Spring and Summer programs. Our NEW OFFICE LOCATION is in the same building as the Princeton Junction Post Office in the Municipal Complex at the corner of Clarksville and North Post Roads.

CANCELLATION POLICY

The Division of Recreation and Parks reserves the right to cancel any program if there is insufficient enrollment. Dates and times of scheduled programs are subject to change due to circumstances beyond the control of the Division of Recreation and Parks. Also, additional programs may be scheduled which are not included in this directory. Every effort will be made to keep residents informed of all program changes.

REFUND POLICY

Please read the following statement carefully. **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.** Prior withdrawal: Registrants who withdraw prior to the start of a program may be issued a refund only if the Division of Recreation and Parks is notified in writing at least two weeks prior to the start of the program. No refunds will be granted once a program has begun. A 20% administrative service charge will be imposed for all refunds granted. Please be advised that the several of the Summer Day Camps have separate refund policies.

RETURNED CHECK POLICY

There will be a penalty fee of \$20 for each program payment check returned by the bank for insufficient funds. To maintain registration in the program, payment must be made in cash to the Division of Recreation and Parks in the amount of the returned check. Individuals who are penalized once for a returned check will be required to make all future payments for program fees in cash.

Pavilion Rentals

Community Park

Families and other groups may reserve the picnic pavilion at the Community Park for picnics and other functions. The pavilion can accommodate groups of up to 100 guests. Restrooms are available. Groups may bring their own grills. Applications are available at the Recreation Office. The rental fee to use this facility for a 4 hour block of time is \$150.00 for residents and \$300.00 for non-West Windsor residents. There is also a \$75.00 refundable damage deposit.

Van Nest Park

Families and other groups may reserve Van Nest Park for picnics and other functions. Park facilities include a pavilion, tables and grills, new permanent bathrooms, playground and an open space for games. The parking lot is paved and the park is accessible. The park is located on Cranbury Road adjacent to Grover's Mill Pond. Applications are available at the Recreation Office. Groups of twenty or more may rent the facility for a 4 hour block of time for \$150.00 (residents) and \$300.00 (for non-residents). There is also a \$75.00 refundable damage deposit.

Special Needs Programs

West Windsor Recreation offers year round programs for adults and teenagers with special needs. Previously offered programs include Yoga, Chorus, Dance Aerobics, Cooking, Trips and more.
